

You will be welcomed at the airport and driven to your hotel in Sacred Valley.

On route, visit in the small town of **Pisac**. Well-known amongst locals and tourists, the bazaar-like open market offers a wide selection of Peruvian **handicrafts**: ceramics, paintings, weavings, and jewelry.

About 58km (36mi.) away, explore the impressive ruins of **Ollantaytambo**, one of the few places where the Incas won a battle against the Spaniards. Climb up the platforms and enjoy the view above the village and onto the valley. Near the ruins, visit a **typical home** and learn about the unique way their family has lived for generations in the Sacred Valley.

****Remark:** In Pisac, the main market days are Tuesday, Thursday and Sunday. There is a smaller market on other days.

You will be picked up at given time from your hotel and taken to the train station of Ollantaytambo.



At the train station, board the **panoramic train** and enjoy the stunning Andean views filled with small communities and snow-capped mountains in the **Sacred Valley**. When you arrive to **Aguas Calientes**, the small village nestled at the bottom of **Machu Picchu**, take the shuttle bus up to the ancient citadel. Learn about the Inca civilization, the site's discovery, and the different theories on this mysterious and spectacular archeological site.

***Machu Picchu** is on every traveler's bucket list: it is undoubtedly one of the "must-see" archeological sites in the world. The most remarkable site from the Inca Empire was never found by the Spaniards and was re-discovered during the 20th century. Since then, archeologists continue to investigate, excavate, and reconstruct the ancient city that used to serve as a political, religious, and administrative center. Temples, agricultural terraces, and archeological observatories enclose a history and a mystery that go back thousands of years.*

After this matchless day, take the bus back down to Aguas Calientes and then continue with the train to Ollantaytambo.

You will be taken from Ollantaytambo to your hotel in Cusco.

Make your way through small alleys edged with Incan walls until you reach **Koricancha**, the temple dedicated to the sun "Inti". Believed to be the most important temple for the Incas, it was destroyed by the Spanish conquerors in the 16th century. Its foundations were used to build the Catholic Church Santo Domingo. Continue your journey into the past as you explore the different Inca ruins around Cusco. The, you will visit **Sacsayhuamán**, the Inca ceremonial fortress dedicated to the sun. Admire the gigantic rocks used to build the site and the way they were perfectly fitted together.

End your tour at the typical **San Pedro market** and take in the lively bustle of the workers and their colorful stands filled with fruits, vegetables, spices, and other local products.

In the evening, you will be picked up from your hotel and driven to the restaurant. After your meal, you will be brought back to your hotel.

LATAM:

LATAM flights no longer include beverages or snacks on board of national flights, there are purchasable options on board the flights which can be bought by Credit Card or in local currency.

Airport taxes in Peru:

The airport taxes for flights in Peru (national and international) are already included in the ticket price. Exception applies to flights over the Nasca Lines from Pisco and Nasca airport.

Important remarks:

- 6-8 weeks prior to arrival a complete passenger list including full name, passport number, nationality, date of birth is required unless otherwise stated. For special products such as cruises we need this information about 9 weeks in advance or according to special cruise conditions.
- Flights not booked via SAT can only be reconfirmed by SAT with the correct and complete file key of your booking.
- Prices for services during national and international holidays, trade fairs and special events are subject to confirmation at the time of booking. Non-refundable advance payments may be made for these periods.
- SAT is not responsible for any belongings of the passengers carried during any services rendered by SAT, such as transfers or tours
- SAT is able to provide headsets (microphone for guide and receivers for guests) for group tours in the main cities. Cost and availability can be checked with your contact at SAT.
- Rates for hotel services are based on bookings made by non-resident foreign visitors. For nationals or foreigners resident in this country rates are not valid and a surcharge of 18% local tax applies on all hotel services. This surcharge also applies in case the booking is based on one foreign passenger and one Peruvian passenger sharing the same room.
- For the train ride with the Belmond Andean Explorer only one 5kg piece of hand luggage is allowed. The extra luggage will be stored in the luggage car of the train during the journey (1 piece of luggage per passenger).
- For the train ride to/from Machu Picchu /Aguas Calientes only one 5kg piece of hand luggage is allowed. In Cusco the extra luggage can be stored at your hotel.
- For the visit of Machu Picchu we recommend good shoes, the trail is without handrail and could be slippery. Walking sticks need to have a rubbery end in order to be permitted inside the Sanctuary. Bags/Backpacks bigger than 40x35x20 as well as umbrellas, selfie sticks, comestibles and plastics like bags, straws and Styrofoam are not permitted.
- For groups travelling through Cusco please note that due to regulations in order to protect the historic buildings and streets, certain larger vehicle sizes are not allowed in some central areas of the city. This implies that that various parts of the city tour will be done walking, and in order to approach hotels groups will be split up temporarily in smaller vehicles, and some vehicles will be travelling for a short period of time without an assistant (driver only). This also applies for groups travelling in large coaches (40+ seats) in the Sacred Valley – for certain visits as well as to access Ollantaytambo train station, smaller vehicles are used for certain periods. The vehicle sizes very much depend on the exact group size. In case you have questions, please check with your contact at SAT.
- Rates are not valid during International Holidays such as Christmas, Easter, New Year (Dec 31/Jan 1), and Labor Day (May 1st), as well as Peruvian Holidays like Inti Raymi (around June 20 to 28), Battle of Angamos (Oct 8 to 11), Peruvian Independence Days (Fiestas Patrias, July 25 to 29), conferences (Perumin Arequipa Sep 25 to 30, 2022) and other big events to be confirmed.

Our quoted hotel rates do not include 18% local VAT tax. Peruvian law exonerates all foreigners visiting Peru for periods of sixty days or less, of the 18% local VAT tax. This will be verified by means of presenting their passport when checking into the hotel, a copy will be taken.

Cancellation charges for hotel services may increase to 118% of the sales rate in case of no-show or last-minute cancellation. In case the requirements are not met by the guests, the 18% local VAT tax will be charged directly to them.

Entrance Fees to Machu Picchu:

Please note that in order to protect the ruins, the entrance tickets to Machu Picchu are restricted. The number of entrance fees available is usually sufficient if bought in advance; however, note that for a possible second day at Machu Picchu we always recommend buying the entrance ticket in advance to avoid disappointment, if not already included in the offer.

Inside the ruin site, 4 different routes (upper and lower circuits, short and long version) are available which our guides will point out, depending on the time of day, fitness level, and personal interest of the guests.

Note that there are no bathrooms inside the citadel and tickets do not allow leaving the citadel and re-entering.

The 3 main sites within the Machu Picchu ruins are limited to the following visiting hours:
