**Puerto Maldonado** is the capital of the Madre de Dios region in the Peruvian Amazon. At the confluence of the Tambopata and Madre de Dios Rivers, it now has many protected parks and natural reserves. Its beautiful landscapes and virgin rainforest hide an incredible biodiversity with unique fauna and flora. There is no doubt that Puerto Maldonado will allow travelers to see, feel, and hear the Amazon first hand.

Arrival and reception at the airport in Puerto Maldonado and drive to the **butterfly farm from Inkaterra**. Afterwards, transfer to the pier at the **Madre de Dios River**. Your boat ride will take 45min until you reach **Inkaterra Reserva Amazonica Lodge**. Check-in and lunch.

The program of Inkaterra Reserva Amazonica Lodge is **flexible** and may be **chosen in coordination by your guide in situ**. The following program is a **suggestion only**.

In the afternoon, you go for a **first exploration** of the surrounding by foot. Prior to dinner, you have an **excursion by boat** in order to experience the atmosphere at dusk.

**\*\*Remark:** Excursions are shared with international travelers and accompanied by an English-speaking guide.

Excursions depend on weather and seasonal circumstances and might be modified by the guide.

Back at the lodge, you will be served a fresh juice made of local ingredients so that waiting time for dinner is not too long.

**LATAM:**

LATAM flights no longer include beverages or snacks on board of national flights, there are purchasable options on board the flights which can be bought by Credit Card or in local currency.

**Airport taxes in Peru:**

The airport taxes for flights in Peru (national and international) are already included in the ticket price. Exception applies to flights over the Nasca Lines from Pisco and Nasca airport.

**Important remarks:**

- 6-8 weeks prior to arrival a complete passenger list including full name, passport number, nationality, date of birth is required unless otherwise stated. For special products such as cruises we need this information about 9 weeks in advance or according to special cruise conditions.
- Flights not booked via SAT can only be reconfirmed by SAT with the correct and complete file key of your booking.
- Prices for services during national and international holidays, trade fairs and special events are subject to confirmation at the time of booking. Non-refundable advance payments may be made for these periods.
- SAT is not responsible for any belongings of the passengers carried during any services rendered by SAT, such as transfers or tours
- SAT is able to provide headsets (microphone for guide and receivers for guests) for group tours in the main cities. Cost and availability can be checked with your contact at SAT.

**Cancellation conditions for land services**

Our quoted hotel rates do not include 18% local VAT tax. Peruvian law exonerates all foreigners visiting Peru for periods of sixty days or less, of the 18% local VAT tax. This will be verified by means of presenting their passport when checking into the hotel, a copy will be taken.

Cancellation charges for hotel services may increase to 118% of the sales rate in case of no-show or last-minute cancellation. In case the requirements are not met by the guests, the 18% local VAT tax will be charged directly to them.

### **Location:**

Located on the banks of Madre de Dios River in the ecological reserve of the Amazon rainforest at about 45min from Puerto Maldonado.

### **Rooms:**

35 jungle camp's thatched cabañas, including superior, superior river view, suite amazonica and suite tambopata. Also, there is the "Canopy Tree House" available, a luxury room at 29 meters including butler service.

All rooms are equipped with, mosquito nets, ceiling fan, electric outlet, private bathrooms with hot water showers, bathroom amenities (eco-friendly), bathrobe/slippers and towels, hypoallergenic pillows, private hammock area with chairs, umbrella and flashlight.

Some amenities as rubber boots, water bottle and additional flashlight are provided by the lodge.

### **Lighting and Electricity:**

Light is provided by generators for several hours a day at morning and night. Kerosene Lamps are available.

### **Facilities:**

Dining room, bar, wellness / Spa area. The lodge is the only one in Puerto Maldonado featuring an elaborated Canopy Walkway.

Tours are made individually, no fixed plans available.
